Equine Show



- 1) For Your Safety **WASH YOUR HANDS** after coming in contact with animals.
- 2) All individuals, associations or companies must receive permission from the executive before they will be permitted to conduct demonstrations, set up a display, sell tickets, sell subscriptions, conduct any form of games, give-aways, draws or business transactions at the Fair. All such activities permitted to operate at the fair will be allotted a given amount of space on the fair grounds and all demonstrations, displays, ticket selling, subscription selling, games, give-aways, draws or business transactions must be confined to the allotted space. Circulating amongst the crowd, use of loud speakers, shouting or use of any device or method that interferes with other activities at the fair is forbidden. Any person or persons, associations or companies violating these rules will be required to leave the fair grounds. The decision of the executive in these matters is final.
- 3) Stock and all articles for competition or exhibition must be entered in the name of bona fide owners, and unless this rule is observed no premium will be awarded and if awarded will be withheld, and the offender debarred from exhibiting at the Society's exhibition for a period of two years.
- 4) No person shall be allowed to enter for exhibition more than one specimen in each section of class. This ruling does not apply to farm animals but to vegetables, produce, fruits, flowers, domestic work, ladies work and manufactured articles.
- 5) All animals competing as purebred must be registered if over one year; if under one year, must be eligible for registration. Pedigrees must be produced on application and transfers made to the present exhibitor. All exhibits must have been owned by the exhibitor at least 30 days prior to the Fair.
- 6) No person shall act as judge for awarding premiums in the class in which he or she is a competitor.
- 7) In the absence of competition in any section, or if the stock or article be of inferior quality the judges are instructed to award only such premium as they think the stock or article deserving of. They will exercise their own discretion as to whether they will award first, second, third or any prize.
- 8) No person shall be allowed to interfere with the judges while in the discharge of their duties. Exhibitors so interfering will forfeit the right to any premium to which they might otherwise be entitled.
- 9) Any infringement of the rules and regulations will be punished by withholding the prizes.
- 10) A meeting of the Directors will be held at the close of the exhibition to hear and decide any complaints or grievances that may have arisen in awarding prizes. Protests for consideration at this meeting must be made to the Secretary in writing, accompanied by \$1.00 which will be forfeited if complaint is not sustained.
- 11) Livestock and implements must be on the grounds not later than 9:00 a.m. on the second day of the exhibition, and shall be on the grounds until the close of the exhibit. Brood mares must have a foal, or evidence she has been in foal the present season.
- 12) No prize tickets or display cards will be allowed on any animal while being judged.
- 13) The Society reserves the right to pay prize money in proportion to receipts. Under no circumstances will the Society be liable to pay prize money in excess of the net revenue derived from the Fair.
- 14) All exhibitors should at all times co-operate with the fair officials in parking of trucks and trailers; proper parking of wagons and buggies and in keeping their stalls in an orderly and tidy condition.
- 15) Exhibitors are asked to refrain at all times, from foul abusive language in and around the stables and in the show ring.
- 16) Stabling and accommodations will be at the discretion of the grounds committee and every attempt will be made to provide adequate facilities.
- 17) In the case that there are less than 3 entries in a class, the class may be combined with another age group in that same class description.

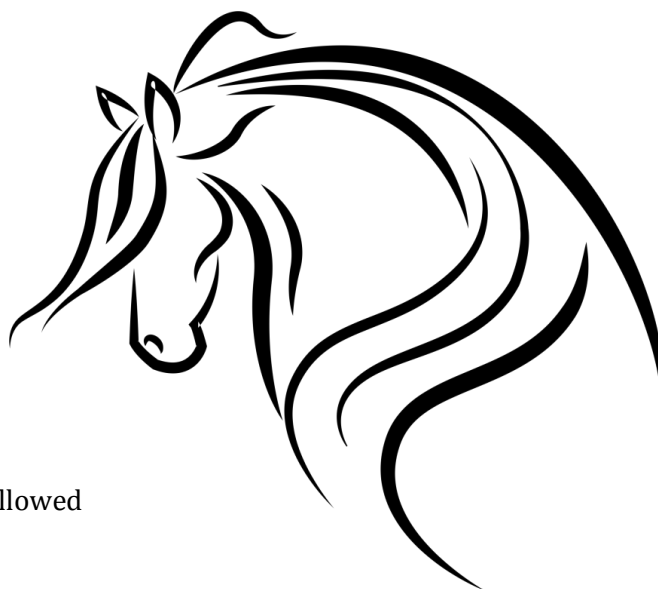
